#### What we do

## Summary of role

Bible Society implemented Salesforce (with Non-Profit Success Pack) with a successful roll-out in March 2023. Bible Society is now seeking to extend the scope of the CRM beyond the initial teams using Salesforce and integrate it into other Bible Society systems and processes.

Working as part of the wider Technology department, the Salesforce Developer role will report to the Salesforce Project Manager, working closely with our Technical Solutions Specialist. The role will be working with the Technical Solutions Specialist to further develop our Salesforce environment and related systems to support more of Bible Society's CRM needs, including developing critical integration projects to help further embed Salesforce across Bible Society, and positioning Salesforce as the source of truth for our organisational customer data.

The successful candidate will be required to work with business stakeholders to understand user needs and develop suitable solutions that fit with Bible Society's technical strategy and Salesforce implementation.

The role requires working with Bible Society's IT team to integrate CRM solutions with Bible Society's IT infrastructure and security configuration, to maintain data security and data protection best practice.

Bible Society's Salesforce implementation includes third-party products from FinDock, Asperato, Plauti, Vonage, etc.

## Main responsibilities

- Effectively analyse business requirements, translating those requirements into customised solutions and improving business efficiency with all development delivered
- Implement the new solutions and ensure they function as required on the Salesforce platform. Ensure all aspects of Salesforce CRM development – including custom objects, flows, lightning web components and apex classes – are operating well
- Develop and test Apex classes, as required
- Develop and test Apex unit tests, as necessary
- Develop Lightning Web components, as required
- Deal with and resolve assigned issues quickly and efficiently

- Implement third-party Salesforce solutions (e.g. document generation, scanning solutions, etc)
- Understand and work with principles and best practice of Data Protection
- Understand and work with principles of DevOps and Salesforce build cycle
- Assist the database team with SOQL queries in Salesforce, helping to resolve any issues quickly
- Develop and test new functionality, changes, updates and faults in the Salesforce environment and related systems. Resolve any issues quickly and efficiently
- Work with external APIs and develop solutions to integrate systems
- Provide technical input in discussions with management and stakeholders
- Work collaboratively with the Salesforce Technical Solutions Specialist to develop best practice, streamline throughput, and ensure consistent high-quality output
- Strive towards coding best practices and data quality
- Contribute to and maintain effective technical documentation
- Maintain effective client relations and rapport, delivering timely and relevant information with the ability to quickly identify and report project risks
